



PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Globally, Southeast Asia is often seen and boasted as a region of rapid economic growth and development.

But for us living in it, we have seen the other side of this progress. News of growth is celebrated in headlines and speeches, yet lands and homes are disappearing before our eyes. New realities rise, but it remains a spectacle and not an experience. Promises of a better future and wealth trickling from private mines, mega corporations, luxury complexes, and urban cities never reaches our hands. To question these changes means to risk being captured, censored, restricted, red-tagged, and persecuted. Silence thickens, fear looms over. Hope turns luxurious. One day, speaking out may no longer be an option. As hunger and hardships become the norm, we pat ourselves on the back and mumble that it is somehow our fault for losing the battle.

This is not what we sign up for. It's an imagination made without us in the picture. And now, it leaves us with the greatest illusion of all—that no one cares and nothing we can do. It's time to change the course and break the illusion. Weave our own version of the future. Hope isn't a gift. We create it, pass it along, and make it louder. It comes through words we write, images we capture, and stories we tell. We dare you to test the waters and prove it yourselves: that the vision you hold dear is not yours alone but shared with many.

We call forth all STORYTELLERS from Southeast Asia to join Just Futures Impact Story Lab, a cohort dedicated to reclaiming our narratives and amplifying our experiences, and be part of the collective shifting of the dominant narrative. When criticism gets shut down, stories and lores will break through the systemic oppression. This cohort will be a space for hearing, learning, and solidarity—where we recognise that our struggles are not isolated, but interwoven. Together, we can amplify our voices and forge movements that flourish across the region. It starts with your story. Let's rewrite the future.

KEY ACTIVITIES

Just Futures Impact Story Lab will be held in Bali, 6–9 September 2025, consisting of:

1. Talks & Discussions

Exchange, discuss, and learn from the STORYTELLERS insights on the current





situation in Southeast Asia, success and failed stories we have made along the way.

2. Workshop

Engage in hands-on exercise sessions to tweak your stories for the better future.

3. Meetings

Get feedback and forge possible collaboration with other STORYTELLERS to further launch your project in the near future.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Medium

We are open for audio-visual projects that addressing issues in Southeast Asia in one of this mediums:

- a. Documentary film (short or feature);
- b. Fiction film (short or feature);
- c. Short-form contents;
- d. Interactive web series;
- e. Campaign videos (commissioned or independent);
- f. Animation videos; or
- g. Audio-visual installation;
- h. Other mediums of audio-visuals.

2. Project & applicant country

The projects and applicants must come from one of this countries:

- a. Brunei;
- b. Cambodia;
- c. Indonesia;
- d. Laos;
- e. Malaysia;
- f. Myanmar;
- g. Philippines;
- h. Singapore;
- i. Thailand;
- j. Timor Leste;
- k. Vietnam.

3. Project perspective

Projects with one of these perspectives:

- a. Fresh perspective in talking about issues that have already been known to a wide audience or;
- b. Giving insight to new issues that haven't been talked about on a wide-spread national/regional scale.

4. Project stage

We welcome projects which have reached one of this stages:

- a. In development (not in the research stage).
- b. In production, with note that the projects should have a trailer.







- c. Editing, with note that the projects should have a rough cut.
- d. Finished/in distribution, with note that the projects are in the process of or have already impacted rightsholder communities in the production/distribution phase of the project, required to share the final cut.

Note:

Accommodation and travel for selected participants will be covered by In-Docs (max. 2 persons per project). We do not cover travel expenses for participants that are coming from (outbound) and going back to (inbound) cities outside the Southeast Asia region.

FORM FILLING

- 1. There are 4 pages to fill in:
 - a. Representative Information
 - b. Project Information
 - c. Applicant Information
 - d. Terms & Conditions
- 2. The form filling does not have to be completed immediately. You can save the filling and continue it later.
 - a. First, click the "Save" button.
 - b. Second, click "Skip Create an Account".
 - c. Next, write an email to send the submission draft, then click the arrow next to the email filling.
 - d. The saved submission will be sent to the email written. The email will be sent in the "Update" category sent by Jotform.
 - e. To continue filling in, please click the "Continue Form" button.
- 3. When the form filling is complete, click the "Review" button to review the submission contents.
- 4. If you are sure that all the contents are correct, click the "Submit" button at the bottom. The "Submit" button will only appear after you click the "Review" button.
- 5. After that, you will enter the "Thank You" page. You will also receive a confirmation email at the registrant's email address.


